

# Victoria's Bushfire Biodiversity Response and Recovery

Progress Update November 2021

The 2019-2020 bushfires have severely impacted Victoria's plants, animals and habitats. In response, coordinated actions led by the Victorian Government are underway to protect our biodiversity and support its recovery.

## Bushfire impacts 2019-2020:

 **1,500,000 HECTARES BURNED**

 **244 SPECIES** with more than 50% of their habitat burnt, including 215 rare or threatened species.

 **9 HABITAT TYPES** had more than 50% of their extent burnt

**14 AT-RISK SPECIES EXTRACTED** FROM FIRE IMPACT, CARED FOR AND RETURNED

**107 SPECIES** OF CONCERN ASSESSED IN THE FIELD TO ENABLE MORE TARGETED ACTIONS

**10 TRADITIONAL OWNER GROUPS** PARTICIPATING IN READING AND HEALING COUNTRY

**>300,000 NEW INVERTEBRATE RECORDS** ADDED TO THE STATE'S PRIMARY DATABASE FOR BIODIVERSITY RECORDS (VICTORIAN BIODIVERSITY ATLAS)

**565,000 HECTARES** OF PEST HERBIVORE CONTROL DELIVERED TO SUPPORT THE RECOVERY OF NATIVE SPECIES

**130,000 HECTARES** OF PEST PREDATOR CONTROL DELIVERED TO SUPPORT THE RECOVERY OF NATIVE SPECIES

**>11,000 HECTARES** OF ASH FOREST RESEEDED BY AIR\*
